

THE STUDY OF LANGUAGES (LOTE)

Margaret River Senior High School provides students with a rich and highly successful Languages curriculum.

Many countries that lead the world in education give Language Studies a high priority. The Nuffield Report in the UK identified four core areas of learning: Literacy, Numeracy, Languages and Technology. In countries that consistently outperform Australia on international literacy and numeracy tests (Pisa tests) such as Finland, students are required to study at least two second Languages throughout their schooling. There is strong evidence for the link between general academic achievement and competency in Languages.

The Australian Universities have responded to the increasing importance of Language studies and UWA is introducing a 10% loading on University Entrance scores for those candidates who will sit for a University Entrance Exam in a Language subject. Other Universities are endorsing this initiative.

At Margaret River Senior High School students are expected to study a selected language for two years in Years 7 and 8. Please consider the choice of Language carefully. In Years 9 to 12 Language will be offered as an elective. This will be dependent on school resources.

Students have a choice of European and Asian Languages. The choice reflects the main languages offered by feeder Primary Schools.
