

## Mobile Phone/Digital Media Policy

- 1. Students are encouraged to avoid bringing mobile phones and other personal digital media to school.
- 2. If you do bring a device, it must be switched off and concealed in a safe place during the day or it will be confiscated. Phones and digital media devices are not to be used during school hours unless

supervised by teachers.

- 1. <u>FIRST CONFISCATION</u>: The device may be collected from Student Services at the end of the day.
- 2. <u>ANY FURTHER CONFISCATIONS</u>: The device may only be collected by a parent or guardian and a meeting held with the Deputy Principal.
- At the discretion of the Deputy Principal-Student Services, students who have repeatedly infringed the mobile phone policy may be required to hand their phone to Student Services Reception on a daily basis, collecting it at the end of the day.
- The school executive team may impose further sanctions including possible internal withdrawal or external suspension for repeated noncompliance including banning a student from bringing a phone or media device to school.
- Any student taking images of students or staff from MRSHS and forwarding onto another party will face automatic suspension.
- Any student placing images of MRSHS students and staff on social media will face automatic suspension.
